RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, For nearly 150 years, Prairie View A&M University 2 has served as a beacon of opportunity for its diverse student body, 3 and its graduates have gone on to contribute to the social, 4 economic, and cultural fabric of society; and

5 WHEREAS, Prairie View A&M University is the second-oldest public institution of higher education in Texas as well as its first 6 7 state-supported college for African Americans; the institution was founded during the Reconstruction Era following the Civil War, with 8 9 the 15th Texas Legislature establishing it as Alta Vista Agricultural and Mechanical College of Texas for Colored Youth in 10 11 1876; and

12 WHEREAS, The university's first class of students, eight young African American men, began their studies at the campus in 13 14 1878; it was originally designated as a normal school for the training of teachers, but after it was approved as a branch campus 15 of the Agricultural Experiment Station and as a Land Grant College, 16 its curriculum expanded to include the arts and sciences, home 17 economics, agriculture, mechanical arts, and nursing; a four-year 18 senior college program was introduced in 1919, and a division of 19 graduate studies, which offered master's degrees in agricultural 20 21 economics, school administration, and other subjects, was added in 22 1937; by an act of the 63rd Texas Legislature, the institution 23 adopted its present-day name, Prairie View A&M University, in 1973; 24 and

WHEREAS, Prairie View A&M has grown considerably over the 1 course of its long history, and during the fall 2024 semester, it 2 3 posted a record-breaking enrollment of nearly 9,900 students; the university offers more than 70 degree programs through its eight 4 5 colleges and schools, including areas of study as varied as engineering, natural sciences, business, and criminal justice; 6 situated on a picturesque campus in rural Prairie View, it welcomes 7 8 students from across the United States and from many foreign countries, and it seeks to invest in programs and services that 9 address the challenges facing the state's diverse ethnic and 10 socioeconomic groups, as well as those facing society and the world 11 12 at large; and

WHEREAS, Since its founding, Prairie View A&M University has equipped generations of students with the knowledge and skills necessary to take their place as leaders in the global community, and it is a privilege to recognize this venerable institution and the contributions that its graduates have made to the Lone Star State and beyond; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas 20 Legislature hereby recognize February 19, 2025, as Prairie View A&M 21 University Day and extend to all those associated with the school 22 sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be prepared for Prairie View A&M as an expression of high regard by the Texas House of Representatives.
