WHEREAS, The University of Mary Hardin-Baylor in Belton is marking the 180th anniversary of its founding with a Charter Celebration on April 11 and 12, 2025; and WHEREAS, The oldest continually operating university in Texas, UMHB traces its roots to February 1, 1845, when the Ninth Congress of the Republic of Texas approved the charter for a new

- 15 changes, including Baylor College for Women in 1925, Mary
- 16 Hardin-Baylor College in 1934, and the University of Mary
- 17 Hardin-Baylor in 1978; among its many historic milestones, it
- 18 served as a model for the Baptist Student Union in 1920, established
- 19 the first school of journalism in a women's college in the United
- 20 States in 1921, and became the first Texas Baptist college to be
- 21 accepted as a full member of the Southern Association of Colleges
- 22 and Schools in 1926; in 1971, the school became coeducational; and
- WHEREAS, Today, UMHB boasts an enrollment of approximately
- 24 3,400 students and employs more than 400 full-time faculty and

- 1 staff; moreover, the school has remained dedicated to Christian
- 2 higher education and has distinguished itself as a leading
- 3 institution in the fields of business, nursing, education, and
- 4 church leadership; and
