1       WHEREAS, The members of the TechnoWizards robotics team have  
2 distinguished themselves through their success at numerous FIRST  
3 Tech Challenge events and their service to the San Antonio  
4 community; and

5       WHEREAS, The FIRST Tech Challenge empowers students to  
6 design, build, program, and operate robots while fostering  
7 essential STEM skills and soft skills such as teamwork,  
8 communication, and problem-solving; and

9       WHEREAS, Established in 2015, the TechnoWizards encompass  
10 students from San Antonio public high schools, charter schools, and  
11 home schools; they have participated in dozens of competitions,  
12 including the FIRST in Texas FTC State Championship, the  
13 FiT-Central Area Championship, and the TX-Central Regional  
14 Championship; the team has been consistently ranked in the top 50 in  
15 the world in recent years, and at the 2022-2023 FIRST World  
16 Championship in Houston, the group earned second place in the  
17 prestigious Think Award category in the Ochoa Division; and

18       WHEREAS, Over the years, the members of the TechnoWizards  
19 have served their community by promoting the importance of STEM  
20 skills among area youth, sharing their technical knowledge, and  
21 volunteering to support nonprofit organizations; they have also  
22 organized a summer robot camp for elementary school students that  
23 takes place at The University of Texas at San Antonio and have held  
24 a robotics technical conference that brings together FTC teams from

1 around the globe; and

2 WHEREAS, Ably guided by coaches Liqun Jin, Xing Tao, Jason  
3 Olkowski, and Yufang Jin and founding coach James Lewey, the  
4 community-based team includes Ilias Bari, Jerry He, Justin Jin,  
5 Vincent Liu, James Lu, Parker Olkowski, Adity Rao, Alejandro  
6 Saucedo, Eduardo Saucedo, Augustine Taboabo, Sebastiano Taboabo,  
7 Dylan Xie, Isabel Xue, and Angela Zhang; and

8 WHEREAS, Since the team's founding, the members of the  
9 TechnoWizards have demonstrated tremendous skill, initiative, and  
10 dedication, and they are a source of great pride to the San Antonio  
11 community; now, therefore, be it
