2 Christi is visiting Austin on February 19, 2025, in celebration of
3 Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi Day at the State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi traces its
5 beginnings to 1947, when the University of Corpus Christi was
6 established; the institution became part of The Texas A&M
7 University System in 1989; and

8 WHEREAS, Today, TAMU-CC serves more than 11,400 students and
9 offers bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees in such fields as
10 business, education, engineering, liberal arts, communication, and
11 nursing; the university continues to introduce new degree programs
12 in its continuing efforts to broaden its curricular offerings,
13 which now include bachelor's degrees in early childhood education
14 and civil and industrial engineering and master's degrees in data
15 science and public health; and

16 WHEREAS, TAMU-CC is home to a number of world-class centers
17 and institutes that carry out autonomous research in geospatial and
