RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Montgomery Independent School District is
marking the 100th anniversary of its founding in 2025; and

3 WHEREAS, Public education has deep roots in the Montgomery community dating back to 1837, when the town was platted and 4 and C. E. Clepper 5 Dr. E. J. Arnold donated land for the construction of a Masonic lodge and a public school; the town's 6 7 citizens went on to create the Montgomery School Association in November 1846 in order to promote education within the community; 8 9 some eight decades later, on March 16, 1925, the Texas Legislature formally established Montgomery ISD with the passage of Senate Bill 10 11 441; and

12 WHEREAS, Initially, the district faced significant 13 challenges, including poor road conditions, financial 14 difficulties, a lack of experienced teachers, and opposition from local residents; yet, by the end of 1926, it had gained strong 15 community support by demonstrating its commitment to offering 16 enhanced educational opportunities through its affiliation with 17 the State Department of Education in English, mathematics, 18 agriculture, and home economics; and 19

20 WHEREAS, The completion of Lake Conroe in 1973 brought a wave 21 of residential and commercial development to the area, resulting in 22 a significant rise in student enrollment and necessitating the 23 expansion of the district's educational facilities and resources to 24 better meet the needs of the community; and

1 WHEREAS, Today, Montgomery ISD encompasses 11 campuses and 2 serves nearly 10,000 students; the district maintains a steadfast 3 dedication to excellence in academics, career and technical 4 education, fine arts, and athletics, and it is committed to 5 preserving its "small town" values, ensuring that the best 6 interests of its students remain at the heart of its mission; and

7 WHEREAS, Over the course of the past century, Montgomery ISD 8 has provided generations of young Texans with a strong foundation 9 on which to build, and it is indeed a privilege to join in marking 10 this important milestone in its history; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas 12 Legislature hereby commemorate the 100th anniversary of the 13 Montgomery Independent School District and extend to the district's 14 administrators, faculty, staff, and students sincere best wishes 15 for continued success; and, be it further

16 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 17 prepared for the district as an expression of high regard by the 18 Texas House of Representatives.
