- 19 Shriners and Scottish Rite; he participated in Pineland Day events,

- 21 moreover, he served with the Pineland Volunteer Fire Department and
- 22 the Sabine County Go Texas Cook-Off Team, and he established the
- 23 D.A.R.E. program in Sabine County schools; and
