1 WHEREAS, The life of an esteemed World War II veteran drew to  
2 a close with the passing of Audon Sanchez Cardenas of San Antonio on  
3 January 31, 2025, at the age of 105; and

4 WHEREAS, A first-generation American, Odón Cardenas was born  
5 to Donaciano and Cecilia Cardenas in Devine on July 30, 1919, and he  
6 grew up with six siblings, Damiana, Dionicio, Erasmo, Guadalupe,  
7 Ernesto, and Sophia; and

8 WHEREAS, Answering his nation's call to duty, Mr. Cardenas  
9 enlisted in the U.S. Army during World War II; following his  
10 promotions to staff sergeant and squad leader, he was deployed with  
11 his battalion to the European Theater in 1944; he was captured by  
12 German forces and held as a prisoner of war before being liberated  
13 in the Battle of the Bulge; in recognition of the great resilience  
14 and bravery he demonstrated during his service and captivity, he  
15 was awarded the American Defense Service Medal and the  
16 European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal, and on August 13,  
17 2019, he was honored as the Veteran of the Day in VA News by the U.S.  
18 Department of Veterans Affairs; after the war, he was a longtime  
19 barber at Lackland Air Force Base, and he became certified in auto  
20 mechanics; and

21 WHEREAS, Deeply dedicated to his family, his faith, and his  
22 country, Odón Cardenas earned the lasting respect and admiration of  
23 all who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it
