1 WHEREAS, Andrea Richardson retired as chief executive
2 officer of Bluebonnet Trails Community Services on December 31,
3 2024, drawing to a close two decades of exemplary service with the
4 Central Texas organization; and

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Richardson took the helm of Bluebonnet Trails
6 Community Services as executive director in 2007; she achieved
7 great distinction in the role, demonstrating strong leadership
8 skills and an effective hands-on approach in overseeing the
9 nonprofit's services to its eight-county region, which includes
10 roughly a dozen rural communities, the Georgetown San Gabriel
11 Crisis Center, and the Bastrop and Elgin Independent School
12 Districts; and

13 WHEREAS, Over the course of her tenure, Ms. Richardson helped
14 expand the reach of BTCS and introduced new mental health and autism
15 programs for youth; headquartered in Round Rock, the organization
16 offers a wide range of programs that offer support to those in need,
17 including early childhood intervention, crisis counseling,
18 substance use care, adult mental health treatment, family health
19 care, and employment and housing assistance; and

20 WHEREAS, Through her dedicated efforts, Andrea Richardson
21 has made a lasting, positive difference in the lives of countless
22 area Texans, and she may indeed reflect with pride on a job well
23 done as she embarks on the next exciting chapter of her life; now,
