WHEREAS, In civilian life, he was a farmer and rancher and 10 later worked in the liquid feed industry while continuing to tend to 11 the land; highly engaged in his community, he gave generously of his 12 time and talents to numerous organizations over the years, 13 14 including the Calhoun County Youth Rodeo Association, the Victoria Economic Development Corporation, Hospice of South Texas, and the 15 16 Calhoun County Cattlemen's Association, where he served as president for more than two decades; in recognition of his 17 contributions, he was named the 2014 Man of the Year by the Port 18 Lavaca Chamber of Commerce; on January 1, 2019, he was sworn in as 19 Calhoun County judge, and at the time of his passing, he was serving 20 21 his second term; and

WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Judge Meyer enjoyed the love and support of his wife of 49 years, Jackie; he was the proud father of two children, Ty and Leslie, and his treasured family eventually
