1           WHEREAS, Carla Campos of Haltom High School reached the  
2 pinnacle of success by winning a gold medal at the 2025 University  
3 Interscholastic League Wrestling State Tournament; and

4           WHEREAS, On February 14 and 15, Ms. Campos joined the other  
5 top high school wrestlers in Texas at the Berry Center in Cypress;  
6 she turned in a stellar performance in the 6A girls' 185-pound  
7 weight division, defeating her Byron P. Steele II High School  
8 opponent by fall in the semifinals to set up a title match showdown  
9 against the two-time defending state champion Rylee Ferranti of  
10 Klein Oak High School; with the state crown on the line, Ms. Campos  
11 recorded a 6-2 decision for the victory; and

12           WHEREAS, Ms. Campos has achieved great success over the  
13 course of her high school wrestling career, collecting three  
14 district championships, two regional crowns, and two state  
15 tournament medals; in addition to receiving All-American honors,  
16 she has twice been named the Most Outstanding Wrestler for Region  
17 1-6A and has been voted the District 4-6A Most Outstanding  
18 Wrestler; and

19           WHEREAS, By claiming a gold medal in the state's premier  
20 showcase for high school wrestlers, Carla Campos has ably  
21 represented her school and community, and she may indeed take  
22 justifiable pride in this exceptional accomplishment; now,
