14 Community Missionary Baptist Church in DeSoto, which has allowed
15 him to blend his professional expertise with his passion for
16 service; throughout his exemplary tenure with CMBC, he has served
17 as both director of logistics and director of community outreach,
18 and in these capacities, he has overseen a number of vital
19 initiatives benefiting underserved communities, including food
20 distribution programs and job and resource fairs; and

21 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Jackson enjoys the love
22 and support of his wife, Portia, and he takes great pride in their 6
23 children and 13 grandchildren; and

24 WHEREAS, Through his steadfast commitment to leadership and
