High School at AT&T Stadium in Arlington; the Indians held a

seven-point advantage at halftime and led by the same margin going

14 into the final frame; with the game knotted at 21-all at the end of

15 regulation, Ganado headed for overtime; a touchdown run put the

16 Indians ahead in the first OT, and their opponent then responded

17 with a scoring throw, tying the contest at 28-28; a scoreless second

18 OT set the stage for an exciting finish in the third extra period to

19 be determined by two-point conversion tries; a completed pass again

20 put Ganado in the lead, and with the title on the line, the team

21 intercepted a pass to seal the win; with the 30-28 victory, Ganado

22 claimed the first state championship in program history and capped

23 the year with an outstanding 15-1 record; and
