3 WHEREAS, Established in 1975, Alamo Area Rape Crisis Center
4 (RCC) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing
5 comprehensive support to survivors of sexual violence in Bexar
6 County and the surrounding region; serving as a trusted resource to
7 survivors, RCC guides clients in processing their trauma,
8 navigating the immediate aftermath, and regaining a sense of safety
9 and agency; and

10 WHEREAS, RCC offers services centered on prevention,
11 intervention, and advocacy, including a free 24-hour crisis
12 hotline, confidential counseling, case management, and educational
13 programming; the organization conducts training and outreach with
14 the goal of preventing incidents of sexual violence in the San
15 Antonio area, and it adapts its strategies and programs in response
16 to survivor feedback and emerging challenges; and

17 WHEREAS, Over the past half-century, Alamo Area Rape Crisis
18 Center has been a beacon of hope to countless victims of sexual
19 violence, and this milestone anniversary serves as a welcome
20 opportunity to recognize this commendable organization for its
21 efforts to make the community a safer and more compassionate place
