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## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Rett Syndrome Awareness Month is being observed in
- 2 October 2025 to promote better understanding of this developmental
- 3 disorder; and
- WHEREAS, Every two hours, a child is born with Rett syndrome,
- 5 a rare postnatal genetic neurological disorder that occurs almost
- 6 exclusively in females; symptoms first appear in infants and
- 7 toddlers between the ages of 6 to 18 months, followed by a period of
- 8 regression when motor skills are gradually lost over time; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Individuals with Rett syndrome require assistance
- 10 with daily tasks throughout their lives; more than half of those
- 11 diagnosed with the condition lose their ability to walk, and many
- 12 suffer from impairments such as loss of speech, seizures,
- 13 scoliosis, and irregular breathing patterns; one of the most
- 14 distinctive signs of Rett syndrome is near constant repetitive hand
- 15 movements while awake; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Biomedical research suggests that neurological
- 17 symptoms may be reversed even decades after diagnosis; scientists
- 18 discovered the gene that causes Rett syndrome in 1999, and there
- 19 have since been several breakthroughs in developing a cure; the
- 20 first FDA-approved treatment launched in 2023; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The International Rett Syndrome Foundation is one of
- 22 the world's largest private sources of funds for Rett syndrome
- 23 research; the organization works to address the full spectrum of
- 24 the disorder while advocating for policies that enhance the quality

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- 1 of life for patients and their families; and
- WHEREAS, Rett syndrome is a serious and life-changing
- 3 condition, and Rett Syndrome Awareness Month serves as a means of
- 4 rallying support for vital research and resources that can help
- 5 improve the outlook for those living with the disorder; now,
- 6 therefore, be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas
- 8 Legislature hereby recognize October 2025 as Rett Syndrome
- 9 Awareness Month and encourage all Texans to learn more about the
- 10 condition.
