1 WHEREAS, Ayaan Moledina has distinguished himself through  
2 his exceptional work as an advocate for the youth community in  
3 Texas; and

4 WHEREAS, A student at St. Stephen's Episcopal School in  
5 Austin, Mr. Moledina serves as federal policy director of Students  
6 Engaged In Advancing Texas and vice chair of the organization's  
7 board; among his many duties, he has championed legislative efforts  
8 regarding suicide prevention, bullying, mental health, and youth  
9 representation in government; he also worked on federal policy  
10 during his internship with the American Foundation for Suicide  
11 Prevention; as the deputy executive director of the Youth Power  
12 Project, he helped organize the 2024 White House Youth Suicide  
13 Prevention Roundtable, guided advocacy at the Texas Legislature,  
14 and assisted with bills at the local, state, and national levels;

17 several other advocacy groups, including as public health student  
18 ambassador for ProtectUS, as advocacy associate for Voters of  
19 Tomorrow, as director of partnerships for GENup, and as vice

21 Vaccines; he has further given of his time and talents as a board  
22 member of Team ENOUGH, This Is My Brave, and the Round Rock ISD  
23 School Health Advisory Council and as digital director of the  
24 American Muslim and Multifaith Women's Empowerment Council, CALPAK

1 Education Services, and the Pakistani-American Democratic Club of  
2 Orange County; moreover, he participates in his school's chapter of  
3 Active Minds, and he previously served as a  
4 Watson-Eckhardt-Talarico Campaign Academy fellow for the Travis  
5 County Democratic Party and as a civic engagement fellow for Asian  
6 Texans for Justice; in addition, he has completed internships in  
7 the offices of State Representative Vikki Goodwin,  
8 U.S. Representative Lloyd Doggett, and California State Senator  
9 Dr. Richard Pan; and

10 WHEREAS, Ayaan Moledina has demonstrated an unwavering  
11 commitment to engaging in the legislative process and to improving  
12 the lives of his fellow young Texans, and his myriad efforts are  
13 indeed deserving of recognition; now, therefore, be it
