1 WHEREAS, The Nickel Sandwich Grill in Houston celebrated its
2 24th anniversary on April 4, 2025; and

3 WHEREAS, The restaurant's founder, Craig Presley, grew up in
4 the historic Fifth Ward neighborhood and graduated from Phillis
5 Wheatley High School and Texas Southern University; he owned and
6 operated a Blimpie franchise for two years before joining the
7 Houston Independent School District to teach biology to at-risk
8 students; determined to own his own business and to set an example
9 of entrepreneurship for area youth, he cashed in his teacher
10 retirement to establish a restaurant in the Fifth Ward; the Nickel
11 Sandwich Grill opened its doors in March 2001; over the years, the
12 restaurant has given back to the community by sponsoring school and
13 neighborhood activities and participating in summer youth
14 employment programs; and

15 WHEREAS, The Nickel Sandwich Grill has won the loyalty of
16 many Houston residents while contributing to the prosperity of the
17 local economy, and it has attained the status of a treasured
18 community institution; now, therefore, be it
