6 was promoted to equipment operator in March 2007 and to lieutenant

10 community through his efforts as president of the Lubbock
11 Professional Firefighters Association; during his tenure, he
12 played a vital role in the LPFFA's COATS4KIDS initiative, which
13 delivers winter jackets to local children in need; in retirement,
14 he plans to stay involved with COATS4KIDS and to spend time with his
15 family; and

16 WHEREAS, Chris Kemp's leadership, hard work, and commitment
17 to excellence have greatly benefited the citizens of Lubbock and
18 earned him the respect and admiration of his fellow first
19 responders, and he may indeed reflect with pride on a career well
