

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Taylor Nunez of Randolph High School in Universal
2 City won four gold medals at the 2025 University Interscholastic
3 League Track & Field State Meet to close out her spectacular career
4 as the most decorated athlete in Texas high school track history;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, On May 1, Ms. Nunez joined the other top 3A
7 competitors at Mike A. Myers Stadium in Austin; starting her day in
8 thrilling fashion, she claimed her fourth straight gold medal in
9 the long jump, breaking her own record with a leap of 20 feet, 9.5
10 inches; she continued to excel in the running events, eclipsing her
11 previous 3A mark with a winning time of 11.22 seconds in the 100
12 meters and clocking in at 22.76 seconds in the 200-meter race to
13 capture the 15th gold medal of her career; with that effort, she
14 established the gold-medal standard for all male and female track
15 athletes in the state; and

16 WHEREAS, In the final event of the night, Ms. Nunez further
17 contributed to Randolph High's superb showing by anchoring the
18 4x400-meter relay squad; teaming with Jaela Smith, Sophia Bendet,
19 and Grace Kistler, she took the baton for the last time at the state
20 meet, bringing home the quartet's victory with a blistering time of
21 3 minutes, 47.72 seconds, for a 3A record and her 16th gold medal;
22 remarkably, Ms. Nunez completed a perfect 16-for-16 run of gold
23 medals in UIL state competition, and the Ro-Hawks earned their
24 fourth consecutive team title with their overall performance; and

1 WHEREAS, Ms. Nunez has signed a letter of intent to compete
2 in track at Texas A&M University; this accomplished young athlete
3 is continuing a family tradition with her success in the sport; her
4 mother, Tameka Nunez, was a seven-time All-American while competing
5 for The University of Texas at San Antonio under her maiden name,
6 Tameka Roberts; and

7 WHEREAS, Demonstrating exceptional talent, dedication, and
8 perseverance, Taylor Nunez has cemented her place in the pantheon
9 of exceptional track athletes in the Lone Star State, and she is
10 poised for further success as she looks ahead to her collegiate
11 athletic career; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas
13 Legislature hereby congratulate Taylor Nunez on winning four gold
14 medals at the 2025 UIL Track & Field State Meet and extend to her
15 sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further

16 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
17 prepared for Ms. Nunez as an expression of high regard by the Texas
18 House of Representatives.
