R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Mary Talley Bowden, a board-certified  
2 otolaryngologist and sleep specialist in Houston, has dedicated her  
3 medical practice to the well-being of patients, particularly during  
4 the COVID-19 pandemic; and

5 WHEREAS, A vocal advocate for patient access to early  
6 treatment protocols, Dr. Bowden has emphasized a proactive  
7 approach to mitigating severe outcomes associated with COVID-19;  
8 she has successfully treated more than 6,000 COVID-19 patients  
9 using early intervention strategies, which have contributed to  
10 reduced hospitalizations and improved patient recovery with no loss  
11 of life; and

12 WHEREAS, Committed to medical freedom and patient autonomy,  
13 Dr. Bowden has reinforced the importance of individualized  
14 treatment plans, allowing patients to receive care tailored to  
15 their specific needs; moreover, her advocacy for physician  
16 independence and patient rights has encouraged dialogue on broader  
17 health care policies and access to treatment options beyond  
18 conventional methodologies; and

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Bowden's efforts have garnered national  
20 recognition, highlighting the importance of alternative  
21 perspectives in the ongoing discourse regarding pandemic response  
22 and treatment options; she currently serves as a senior fellow with  
23 the Independent Medical Alliance and as a member of the board of  
24 directors of the Vaccine Safety Research Foundation; and

1       WHEREAS, Dr. Bowden has exemplified the highest standards of  
2 medical ethics by prioritizing patient care, upholding the  
3 physician's duty to do no harm, and challenging regulatory barriers  
4 that may limit treatment choices; now, therefore, be it

5       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas  
6 Legislature hereby commend Dr. Mary Talley Bowden for her  
7 contributions to the treatment of COVID-19 patients through early  
8 intervention protocols and for her continued commitment to patient  
9 care and medical innovation; and, be it further

10       RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
11 prepared for Dr. Bowden as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
12 House of Representatives.
