R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, El Paso Children's Hospital is celebrating the 13th
2 anniversary of its founding in 2025; and

3 WHEREAS, The idea to establish a hospital in El Paso
4 specializing in pediatric care was first conceived by a group of
5 concerned citizens in 1993, and after years of advocacy, Thomason
6 Hospital took on the project; in November 2007, local voters
7 approved a bond issue for the facility, and on February 14, 2012,
8 the hospital opened its doors; and

9 WHEREAS, Since its inception, El Paso Children's Hospital has
10 helped to decrease outmigration for pediatric subspecialty and
11 surgical care by 80 percent; accredited by The Joint Commission and
12 the College of American Pathologists, the hospital is home to a
13 Level IV neonatal intensive care unit as well as the Southwest
14 University Pediatric Blood and Cancer Unit; moreover, the facility
15 has the distinction of being an affiliate of Children's Oncology
16 Group; and

17 WHEREAS, Over the past 13 years, El Paso Children's Hospital
18 has provided expert and compassionate care to countless young
19 Texans, and the members of its medical, support, and administrative
20 staff may indeed take great pride in its outstanding record of
21 service; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas
23 Legislature hereby commemorate the 13th anniversary of El Paso
24 Children's Hospital and extend to all those associated with the

1 institution sincere best wishes for continued success with their
