R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Associated General Contractors of Texas  
2 Highway, Heavy, Utilities, and Industrial Branch, a trade group  
3 serving businesses in the infrastructure construction industry,  
4 marked the 100th anniversary of its founding on December 11, 2024;

6 WHEREAS, In November 1924, a group of Texas contractors met  
7 at the St. Anthony Hotel in San Antonio to begin developing the  
8 framework for an organization committed to advocating in behalf of  
9 general contractors and meeting the state's growing public  
10 infrastructure needs; on December 11 of that year, a charter for the  
11 group was granted by the Associated General Contractors of America,  
12 ushering in a new era of growth and success for the highway and  
13 heavy construction industry in Texas; and

14 WHEREAS, The more than 700 companies affiliated with the AGC  
15 of Texas are responsible for over 90 percent of all highway  
16 construction in the state and a considerable share of other  
17 engineering projects, including water and sewer systems and utility  
18 plants; throughout its existence, the organization has tirelessly  
19 advocated for the funding of the state highway system, promoted  
20 workplace safety, and championed the core values of skill,  
21 integrity, and responsibility among contractors, suppliers, and  
22 industry professionals doing business in Texas; under the able  
23 leadership of chief executive officer Jennifer Woodard, the group  
24 strives to be a driving force in shaping the future of public

1 infrastructure in Texas, contributing to the continued economic  
2 vitality of the state; and

3 WHEREAS, Thanks to the dedication of its engaged membership,  
4 the Associated General Contractors of Texas continues to flourish  
5 as one of the longest-standing trade groups in the Lone Star State,  
6 and it is a privilege to honor the organization as it commemorates a
