1 WHEREAS, Greater Houston Frontiers Club Day at the State
2 Capitol is taking place on May 20, 2025; and

3 WHEREAS, The Greater Houston Frontiers Club is a chapter of
4 Frontiers International, which was founded in 1936 by Nimrod B.
5 Allen, a respected leader in the African American community; the
6 organization initially focused on promoting civic engagement among
7 African American men, and it later opened its membership to women;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, Since its inception nearly three decades ago, the
10 Greater Houston Frontiers Club has awarded over \$1 million in
11 scholarships to underserved high school students in Harris County;
12 the volunteer organization has further contributed to the community
13 through events and initiatives such as the annual Dr. Martin Luther
14 King Jr. Memorial Scholarship Breakfast, Toys for Kids, Wreaths
15 Across America, and Turkey on Every Table; in addition, it has
16 partnered with a number of other groups to improve the quality of
17 life for area residents; and

18 WHEREAS, The Greater Houston Frontiers Club has made a
19 positive difference in the community and empowered countless young
20 Texans to achieve their full academic potential, and it is a
21 pleasure to join in honoring the organization for its
22 contributions; now, therefore, be it
