- 15 Norte, capturing Guadalupe not as a distant icon but as a living
- 16 symbol of borderland resilience, intertwining indigenous
- 17 traditions with Catholic faith, and reflecting the unique cultural
- 18 tapestry of El Paso-Juárez; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Andrew Joseph Perez, whose expansive creative
- 20 career includes achievements in photography, video direction,
- 21 painting, sculpture, educational games, literature, and
- 22 data-driven storytelling, returned to El Paso in 2009 to enhance
- 23 and reshape local narratives, employing emerging technologies and
- 24 innovative practices through his tech startup, Guide, and various
