1 WHEREAS, The Round Rock Community Choir is celebrating its
2 40th anniversary in 2025, and this occasion provides a welcome
3 opportunity to honor this respected arts group; and

4 WHEREAS, Founded in 1985, the Round Rock Community Choir was
5 established by Dr. Linda Bolding and a group of local residents who
6 were passionate about expanding the quality and variety of the
7 area's performing arts offerings; each season, the ensemble
8 showcases three concerts featuring music that spans such genres as
9 classical, Broadway, bluegrass, and Celtic, and its free holiday
10 concert is an annual community tradition; in addition, the choir
11 sings the national anthem at the opening day game of the Round Rock
12 Express baseball team each April, and the group entertains the
13 attendees of the Round Rock Arts Fest every fall; and

14 WHEREAS, To better serve the individual talents of its
15 members, the choir also serves as the umbrella organization to
16 three ensembles, Bella Voce, Camerata, and the Round Rock Youth
17 Choir; the Round Rock Community Choir is ably led by its board of
18 directors, which includes president Christopher Walker, vice
19 president of fundraising Jordan Kapusinski, vice president of
20 membership Jill Haehnel, and artistic director David Allen; and
