R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, A rich and purposeful life drew to a close with the
2 passing of Alan George Moravcik of Midland on August 20, 2024, at
3 the age of 77; and

4 WHEREAS, The son of John and Sylvia Moravcik, Alan Moravcik
5 was born in Hays, Kansas, on December 12, 1946, and he grew up in
6 Odessa with the companionship of a brother, Jack; after graduating
7 from Permian High School, he attended The University of Texas at
8 Austin on an athletic scholarship and played both football and
9 baseball for the Longhorns; he earned his juris doctor degree from
10 UT in 1972; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Moravcik practiced law in Austin for nine years
12 before joining a firm in Midland; he eventually founded his own
13 practice and later teamed with Mark Threadgill and Stuart Starry to
14 form the law firm Moravcik, Threadgill & Starry; over the course of
15 nearly four decades in family law, he often took pro bono cases, and
16 he frequently took opportunities to protect children in need; and

17 WHEREAS, In 1991, Mr. Moravcik married the love of his life,
18 Cathie Rae, and the couple shared 33 years together; he took great
19 pride in their children, Blake, Jake, and Maddie, and their
20 grandchildren, Taylor, Maci, and Alex; proud of his Czech heritage,
21 he was admired for his wonderful sense of humor, his love for
22 animals, and his strong faith; he especially enjoyed cooking for
23 his family and friends and coaching his sons and nephew in baseball;

2 sadness to his family and friends, he leaves behind a legacy that
3 will long be treasured by all those who held him dear; now,
