

Suspending limitations on conference committee
jurisdiction, H.B. No. 3556 (Vasut/Middleton)

R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 89th Legislature, 2025, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be
3 suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to
4 enable the conference committee appointed to resolve the
5 differences on House Bill 3556 (the construction of structures
6 exceeding a certain height in certain counties containing national
7 wildlife refuges and in adjacent counties) to consider and take
8 action on the following matters:

9 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to permit
10 the committee to change, alter, or amend text not in disagreement in
11 proposed SECTION 1 of the bill, in added Section 12.023(b), Parks
12 and Wildlife Code, by striking "500" and substituting "575".

13 Explanation: The change is necessary to clarify the height
14 of a structure for which a person is required to request Parks and
15 Wildlife Department review before beginning construction.

16 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit
17 the committee to add text on a matter not included in either the
18 house or senate version of the bill in proposed SECTION 1 of the
19 bill, by adding Section 12.023(g), Parks and Wildlife Code, to read
20 as follows:

21 (g) The commission may adopt rules to implement this
22 section.

23 Explanation: The change is necessary to provide the Parks and
24 Wildlife Commission with the authority to adopt rules to implement
