- 11 Education Code, by striking "[content-neutral,]" and substituting
- 12 "content-neutral,".
- 13 Explanation: The change is necessary to clarify that
- 14 restrictions on expressive activities must employ content-neutral
- 15 criteria.
- 16 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit
- 17 the committee to omit text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 2
- 18 of the bill, at the end of amended Section 51.9315(d)(2), Education
- 19 Code, by omitting "and".
- 20 Explanation: The change is necessary to remove unnecessary
- 21 language.
