2 a recipient of a Texas Treasure Business Award from the Texas
3 Historical Commission; and

4 WHEREAS, An initiative of the Texas Historical Commission's
5 Community Heritage Division, the Texas Treasure Business Award
6 program was created in 2005; the award recognizes businesses that
7 have provided jobs and enriched the local economy for 50 years or
8 more, and it pays tribute to the exceptional historical

11 Chicken is located in the Northgate district of College Station

15 Mr. Ganter's death in 2004, his daughters, Jennifer Ganter and Katy
16 Jackson, have operated the beloved establishment; and

19 pleasure to honor the Dixie Chicken for the high regard it has
20 enjoyed in the College Station community over the past half
