BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 1 Texas, 89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025, That House Rule 13, 2 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 resolve the differences on House Bill 46 (the medical use of low-THC 5 under the administration of 6 cannabis and the Texas 7 Compassionate-Use Program; requiring registration) to consider and 8 take action on the following matter:

9 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit the 10 committee to add text on a matter not included in either the house 11 or senate version of the bill in proposed SECTION 15 of the bill, by 12 adding Section 169.003(c), Occupations Code, to read as follows:

13 (c) A physician may prescribe more than one package in a
14 <u>90-day period.</u>

Explanation: The change is necessary to clarify that a hysician may prescribe more than one package of low-THC cannabis to a patient in a 90-day period.
