1           WHEREAS, The Ganado High School softball team capped a  
2   storybook year by winning the 2025 University Interscholastic  
3   League 2A Division 1 state championship; and

4           WHEREAS, The Maidens began their journey to the title by  
5   capturing the District 29-2A title; the team then launched a  
6   dominant playoff run, compiling a 10-0 record while defeating  
7   Refugio, Three Rivers, Thorndale, Flatonia, and Corrigan-Camden  
8   High Schools, with seven of the victories coming by seven runs or  
9   more; and

10          WHEREAS, On May 29, Ganado battled Riesel High School at  
11   McCombs Field in Austin in a thrilling showdown for the state crown;  
12   trailing by a run going into the top of the seventh inning, the  
13   Maidens demonstrated great poise and determination, scoring two  
14   runs on a single to center field and ultimately triumphing by the  
15   final score of 5-4; the Ganado players collected the first softball  
16   state championship in school history and ended the year with an  
17   outstanding record of 33 wins, 5 losses, and 1 tie; and

18          WHEREAS, The Maidens were paced by championship game Most  
19   Valuable Player Kyla Stancik, who was joined on the All-Tournament  
20   team by Paisley Hajovsky, Faith Palacios, Raelynn Pena, Jordyn  
21   Bundick, and Madi Weempe; Ganado also received valuable  
22   contributions throughout the season from the other members of the  
23   roster: Laci Holt, Zoey Ybarra, Avery Torres, Rhylee Green, Hallie  
24   Bures, Saylor Bures, Gwen Reid, Kalyn Benavides, and Isabel

1 Tristan; these dedicated student-athletes were guided by head coach  
2 James Harp and assistant coaches Malina Andel and Matt Ervin; and

3 WHEREAS, Winning a state championship represents the  
4 culmination of countless hours of hard work and an unwavering  
5 commitment to excellence, and the Ganado Maidens will treasure  
6 their memories of this accomplishment for the rest of their lives;  
7 now, therefore, be it

9 Legislature hereby congratulate the Ganado High School softball  
10 team on winning the 2025 UIL 2A Division 1 state championship and
