- SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 466, Government Code, is 21

- 24 INTERNET OR MOBILE INTERNET APPLICATION. (a) A person may not by

telephone or through an Internet application or mobile Internet 1 2 application: 3 (1) purchase or order the purchase of a ticket for a 4 lottery game; or 5 (2) for compensation: 6 (A) accept an order for a ticket for a lottery 7 game from a player; 8 (B) sell a ticket for a lottery game to a player; 9 or (C) arrange: 10 11 (i) to purchase a ticket on behalf of a person playing a lottery game; or 12 13 (ii) for another person to purchase a ticket on behalf of a person playing a lottery game. 14 15 (b) A person commits an offense if the person violates this 16 section. 17 (c) An offense under Subsection (a)(1) is a Class C misdemeanor. 18 (d) An offense under Subsection (a)(2) is a Class A 19
