## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the selection, prioritization, construction, and

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 201.609, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 201.609. NOTICE TO LEGISLATORS OF <u>CERTAIN ACTIONS</u>
- 8 [COMPLETED PROJECTS]. [(a)] Not later than the 10th day after the
- 9 date a major road project is selected for funding or the 10th day
- 10 before the date on which a major road project is scheduled for
- 11 completion, as applicable, the department shall provide notice [of
- 12 the location and completion date of the road project] to each member
- 13 of the legislature who represents the county in which the road
- 14 project is located of:
- 15 (1) the selection of the road project for funding; or
- 16 (2) the completion of the project [and who wants to
- 17 receive the notice].
- 18 [(b) The department shall ask each legislator whether the
- 19 legislator wants to receive notices under this section.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 201.991(a), Transportation Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) The department shall develop a unified transportation
- 23 program covering a period of 10 years to guide the development of

In selecting and prioritizing transportation projects, the Texas Department of Transportation shall: 11 12 (1)develop a plan, conduct an environmental review, and propose a design for: 13 14 the reconstruction of Broadway Street in San 15 Antonio between its intersections with East Houston Street and Burr 16 Road; the reconstruction of Hildebrand Avenue in 17 (B) San Antonio between its intersections between North New Braunfels 18 Avenue and the San Antonio River; 19 20 (C) the construction of State Highway 32 between 21 State Highway 4 and U.S. Highways 77 and 83 in Cameron County; 22 the improvement and extension of Cistercian (D) Road between State Highway 114 and Northgate Drive in Dallas 23 24 County; 25 (E) the improvement and extension of Stewart Road 26 from U.S. Highway 77 to Frontier Parkway in Denton County; the improvement of Fishtrap Road between its

- 3 (G) the improvement of Rockhill Road and Arvin
- 4 Hill Road between the intersection of Rockhill Road and the Union

- 6 Red Mesa Trail in Denton County;
- 7 (H) the construction of a bridge in Harris County
- 8 crossing the railroad tracks at the intersection of Little York

- 11 crossing the railroad tracks at the intersection of Tidwell Road

- 16 (K) the construction of connectors between State

- (N) the expansion of State Highway 57 between the

- (0) the construction of an interchange at the

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- 1 northern intersection of State Highway 349 and Business State
- 2 Highway 349-C in Martin County;
- 3 (P) the improvement and expansion of State
- 4 Highway 349 from its intersection with Business State Highway 349-C
- 5 in Martin County to its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 1788
- 6 in Midland County;
- 7 (Q) the construction of an interchange at the
- 8 intersection of State Highway 349 and Farm-to-Market Road 1788 in
- 9 Midland County;
- 10 (R) the construction of an interchange at the
- 11 intersection of State Highway Loop 250 and Todd Road in Midland
- 12 County; and
- 13 (S) the improvement of Farm-to-Market Road 1660
- 14 between its intersections with Orgain Street and U.S. Highway 79 in
- 15 Williamson County;
- 16 (2) construct the projects described by Subdivision
- 17 (1) of this section; and
- 18 (3) ensure that a route in the state highway system,
- 19 including Farm-to-Market Roads 1021 and 1472, between Eagle Pass
- 20 and Laredo is sufficiently maintained.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
