4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 140, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 140.014 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 140.014. RESTRICTION ON USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS BY
8	POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS TO PAY BAIL BONDS. (a) A political
9	subdivision may not spend public funds to pay a nonprofit
10	organization that accepts and uses donations from the public to
11	deposit money with a court in the amount of a defendant's bail bond.

- 12 (b) If a political subdivision engages in an activity
 13 prohibited by Subsection (a), a taxpayer or resident of the
 14 political subdivision is entitled to appropriate injunctive relief
 15 to prevent further activity prohibited by that subsection and
 16 further payment of public funds related to that activity.
- 17 (c) A taxpayer or resident who prevails in an action under
 18 Subsection (b) is entitled to recover from the political
 19 subdivision the taxpayer's or resident's reasonable attorney's fees
 20 and costs incurred in bringing the action.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
