- 2 relating to the costs associated with the assessment and
- 3 destruction of certain deer.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 43.955(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The <u>department</u> [applicable permit holder] shall pay all
- 8 costs associated with:
- 9 (1) an epidemiological assessment conducted under
- 10 this subchapter to the animal health commission; and
- 11 (2) [except as provided by Subsection (b),
- 12 destruction of deer under this subchapter, including any costs
- 13 <u>associated with the disposal of the deer</u> [to the department].
- SECTION 2. Sections 43.955(b) and (c), Parks and Wildlife
- 15 Code, are repealed.
- 16 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to the payment of costs arising from an epidemiological assessment
- 18 conducted, or the destruction of deer commenced, on or after the
- 19 effective date of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
