- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.005(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The authority responsible for procuring the election
- 8 supplies for an election shall provide:
- 9 $\underline{(1)}$ for each election precinct, a number of ballots
- 10 equal to at least the percentage of voters who voted in that
- 11 precinct in the most recent corresponding election plus 25 percent
- 12 of that number, except that the number of ballots provided may not
- 13 exceed the total number of registered voters in the precinct; and
- 14 (2) unless the number of ballots provided to an
- 15 election precinct is equal to the total number of registered voters
- 16 in the precinct, the means to print additional paper ballots at each
- 17 precinct polling place and early voting polling place.
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 125, Election Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 125.0071 to read as follows:
- 20 <u>Sec. 125.0071. PROVISION OF PAPER BALLOT TO CERTAIN VOTERS.</u>
- 21 (a) An election officer shall provide a paper ballot to a voter who
- 22 <u>requests a paper ballot.</u>
- (b) The secretary of state may prescribe procedures to
- 24 implement this section.

- 1 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an
- 2 election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 3 election ordered before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 4 by the law in effect when the election was ordered, and the former
- 5 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
