4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter B-2 to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER B-2. TEXAS DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY
8	Sec. 411.0281. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "division"
9	means the Texas Division of Homeland Security created under this
10	subchapter.
11	Sec. 411.0282. CREATION OF DIVISION; CHIEF. (a) The Texas
12	Division of Homeland Security is created as a division of the
13	department.
14	(b) Notwithstanding Section 411.015, the division may not
15	be abolished.
16	(c) The director shall appoint a chief to be the division's
17	<pre>chief administrative officer.</pre>
18	Sec. 411.0283. BORDER OPERATIONS. The division may conduct
19	border security operations along the Texas-Mexico border,
20	including:
21	(1) law enforcement operations;
22	(2) intelligence gathering, analysis, and
23	dissemination;

(3) coordination and command of state agencies in

- 1 border security operations led by the division;
- 2 (4) surveillance and detection of criminal activity,
- 3 including illegal entry of individuals from foreign nations and the
- 4 smuggling of individuals and controlled substances, using cameras,
- 5 unmanned aircraft, and other technologies;
- 6 (5) interdiction of individuals committing criminal
- 7 activity described by Subdivision (4);
- 8 (6) coordination of local, state, and federal agencies
- 9 conducting border security operations, including tactical
- 10 operations such as special response teams, brush teams, and special
- 11 weapons and tactics teams; and
- 12 (7) training and education programs for the
- 13 professional development of employees and agency partners carrying
- 14 out border security operations.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
