- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.025(e-2), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (e-2) At the end of each school year, each school district
- 8 shall report through the Public Education Information Management
- 9 System (PEIMS) the number of district students who, during that
- 10 school year [ were ]:
- 11 (1) were enrolled in the foundation high school
- 12 program;
- 13 (2) were pursuing the distinguished level of
- 14 achievement under the foundation high school program as provided by
- 15 Subsection (b-15); [and]
- 16 (3) were enrolled in a program to earn an endorsement
- 17 described by Subsection (c-1); and
- 18 (4) earned each type of performance acknowledgement
- 19 described by Subsection (c-5).
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
