A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a substitute teaching requirement for each member of the senate and the house of representatives. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 301, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 301.074 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 301.074. SUBSTITUTE TEACHING REQUIREMENT. (a) Each 7 member of the senate and the house of representatives shall 8 9 substitute teach at a public school located in the member's district for at least one school day each school year. 10 11 (b) Each member shall report the member's compliance with 12 Subsection (a) to the senate or house committee on administration, as applicable. Each committee shall maintain a list of the members 13 14 in the committee's respective house who do not meet the requirements of this section. The list is public information under 15 16 Chapter 552. SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply 17 beginning with the 2025-2026 school year. 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
