1 AN ACT 2 relating to a grant program to reimburse public schools for certain costs associated with hiring retired teachers. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 21, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 21.416 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 21.416. EMPLOYED RETIREE TEACHER REIMBURSEMENT GRANT PROGRAM. (a) From money appropriated or otherwise available, the 8 9 commissioner shall establish and administer a grant program to reimburse a school district, an open-enrollment charter school, the 10 Windham School District, the Texas School for the Deaf, or the Texas 11 School for the Blind and Visually Impaired for the increased 12 contributions to the Teacher Retirement System associated with 13

- hiring a teacher who retired before September 1, 2024.

 (b) In appropriating money for grants awarded under this
 section, the legislature may provide for, modify, or limit amounts
 appropriated for that purpose in the General Appropriations Act,
 including by:
- 19 (1) providing, notwithstanding Subsection (a), a date
 20 or date range other than September 1, 2024, before which a teacher
 21 must have retired for a school district, an open-enrollment charter
 22 school, the Windham School District, the Texas School for the Deaf,
 23 or the Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired to be

1	(2) limiting eligibility to a district or school
2	described by Subdivision (1) that hires a retired teacher:
3	(A) who holds a certain certification;
4	(B) to teach a certain subject or grade;
5	(C) in a certain geographical area; or
6	(D) to provide instruction to certain students,
7	including to students with disabilities.
8	(c) If the total amount of money sought by eligible
9	districts or schools exceeds the amount of money appropriated or
10	otherwise available for the purpose, the commissioner shall
11	prioritize awarding grants to eligible districts or schools with
12	the most need, beginning with districts or schools that hire a
13	retired teacher to teach special education or bilingual education.
14	(d) A school district, an open-enrollment charter school,
15	the Windham School District, the Texas School for the Deaf, or the
16	Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired may use money
17	received under this section to make required payments under Section
18	825.4092, Government Code.
19	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
20	school year.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
24	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
25	Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
