4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the Historic Texas
6	Freedmen's Cemetery Designation Act.
7	SECTION 2. Chapter 442, Government Code, is amended by
8	adding Subchapter H to read as follows:
9	SUBCHAPTER H. HISTORIC TEXAS FREEDMEN'S CEMETERY DESIGNATION
10	PROGRAM
11	Sec. 442.301. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "program"
12	means the Historic Texas Freedmen's Cemetery Designation Program.
13	Sec. 442.302. ESTABLISHMENT AND PURPOSE. The commission
14	shall establish the program to alert the public, as well as current
15	and future owners of land adjacent to the cemetery:
16	(1) of the existence of the cemetery; and
17	(2) that the cemetery contains the graves of freed
18	slaves.
19	Sec. 442.303. ELIGIBILITY. To be eligible for a
20	designation under the program, a cemetery must:
21	(1) contain the grave of at least one freed slave; and
22	(2) meet other requirements determined by the
23	commission.
24	Sec. 442.304. APPLYING FOR DESIGNATION. (a) Any person may

The applicant must include as part of the application (b) 3 4 information establishing: 5 (1) the existence of the cemetery; and 6 (2) that the cemetery contains the grave of at least 7 one freed slave. Sec. 442.305. NOTICE OF APPLICATION. After the commission 8 9 receives an application to designate a cemetery under the program, the commission shall notify the following persons of the 10 11 application: 12 (1) the owner of the property containing the cemetery; 13 (2) each owner of property adjacent to the cemetery; <u>an</u>d 14 (3) the cemetery organization, as defined by Section 15 16 711.001, Health and Safety Code, if applicable. 17 Sec. 442.306. APPLICATION REVIEW; DECISION. (a) The commission shall review each application it receives 18 for designation of a cemetery under the program and determine whether 19 20 the cemetery qualifies for designation under the program. (b) If the commission determines the cemetery qualifies for 21 a designation under the program, the commission shall: 22 23 (1) approve the application; (2) notify the applicant of the approval of the 24 25 application; and (3) inform the applicant that the cemetery may be 26 27 recognized with a medallion available for purchase from the

1	commission to certify the cemetery's participation in the program.
2	(c) If the commission determines the cemetery does not
3	qualify for designation under the program, the commission shall
4	either:
5	(1) request additional information from the applicant
6	to support the application; or
7	(2) deny the application.
8	(d) If the commission denies the application for
9	designation under the program, the commission shall notify the
10	applicant of the denial and inform the applicant of the ability to
11	appeal the decision to the members of the commission.
12	Sec. 442.307. APPLICATION FORM; FEE; MEDALLION. (a) The
13	commission shall develop an application form and procedure for
14	applying for a designation under the program. The commission shall
15	post the application on the commission's Internet website.
16	(b) The commission may charge an application fee not to
17	exceed \$25 for each application submitted under this subchapter.
18	(c) The commission shall design a medallion that may be used
19	to identify cemeteries that receive a designation under the
20	program.
21	Sec. 442.308. RULES. The commission shall adopt rules as
22	necessary to implement this subchapter.
23	SECTION 3. Not later than June 1, 2026, the Texas Historical
24	Commission shall adopt rules to administer the Historic Texas
25	Freedmen's Cemetery Designation Program established under
26	Subchapter H, Chapter 442, Government Code, as added by this Act.
27	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
