9	(1) "Compact" means the Interstate Compact on
10	Educational Opportunity for Military Children executed under
11	Section 162.002.
12	(2) "Uniformed services" means:
13	(A) the United States Army, Navy, Air Force,
14	Space Force, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard;
15	(B) the Commissioned Corps of the National
16	Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration; or
17	(C) the Commissioned Corps of the United States

- 19 (b) The provisions of Articles IV, V, VI, and VII of the
- 20 compact apply to the following children as if those children were
- 21 children described by Article III of the compact:
- (1) a child of a veteran of the uniformed services who
- 23 was discharged or released through retirement, for a period of four
- 24 years after the date of the veteran's retirement, if the veteran

- 1 returns to the veteran's home of record on military orders; and
- 2 (2) a child of a member of the uniformed services who
- 3 dies on active duty or as a result of injuries sustained on active
- 4 duty, for a period of four years after the member's death.
- 5 (c) Each school district and open-enrollment charter school
- 6 that maintains an Internet website shall post on the district's or
- 7 <u>school's Internet website an easily accessible link to information</u>
- 8 regarding the compact and the additional protections provided by
- 9 this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 11 school year.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
