2	relating to prohibiting the offering for sale and the sale of
3	cell-cultured protein; providing penalties.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 431.002, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subdivision (5-a) to read as follows:
7	(5-a) "Cell-cultured protein" means a food product
8	derived from harvesting animal cells and artificially replicating
9	those cells in a growth medium to produce tissue.
10	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 431, Health and Safety
11	Code, is amended by adding Section 431.02105 to read as follows:
12	Sec. 431.02105. PROHIBITED ACT; TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a)
13	The offering for sale or sale of cell-cultured protein for humar
14	consumption within this state is unlawful and prohibited.
15	(b) A violation of this section may be enforced in the same
16	manner as a violation of Section 431.021 is enforced under
17	Subchapter C.
18	(c) This section expires September 1, 2027.

- 19 SECTION 3. Sections 431.0805(4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9),
- 20 and (10), Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 21 (4) "Egg" has the meaning assigned by Section 4(g),
- 22 Egg Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section 1033(g)). The term
- 23 does not include an analogue product or $[\frac{1}{4}]$ cell-cultured protein
- 24 [product].

- 1 (5) "Egg product" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 2 4(f), Egg Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section 1033(f)). The
- 3 term does not include an analogue product or [a] cell-cultured
- 4 protein [product].
- 5 (6) "Fish" has the meaning assigned by Section 403 of
- 6 the federal Act (21 U.S.C. Section 343(q)(4)(E)). The term does not
- 7 include an analogue product or [a] cell-cultured protein [product].
- 8 (7) "Meat" has the meaning assigned by 9 C.F.R.
- 9 Section 301.2. The term does not include an analogue product or $\left[\frac{a}{a}\right]$
- 10 cell-cultured protein [product].
- 11 (8) "Meat food product" has the meaning assigned by
- 12 Section 1(j), Federal Meat Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section
- 13 601(j)). The term does not include an analogue product or [a]
- 14 cell-cultured protein [product].
- 15 (9) "Poultry" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 16 4(e), Poultry Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section 453(e)).
- 17 The term does not include an analogue product or $[\frac{1}{4}]$ cell-cultured
- 18 protein [product].
- 19 (10) "Poultry product" has the meaning assigned by
- 20 Section 4(f), Poultry Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section
- 21 453(f)). The term does not include an analogue product or [a]
- 22 cell-cultured protein [product].
- SECTION 4. Section 433.0415, Health and Safety Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 433.0415. LABELING CELL-CULTURED PROTEIN [PRODUCT].
- 26 (a) In this section:
- 27 (1) "Cell-cultured protein [product]" has the meaning

- 1 assigned by Section 431.002 [431.0805].
- 2 (2) "Close proximity" means:
- 3 (A) immediately before or after the name of the
- 4 product;
- 5 (B) in the line of the label immediately before
- 6 or after the line containing the name of the product; or
- 7 (C) within the same phrase or sentence containing
- 8 the name of the product.
- 9 (b) Cell-cultured protein [A cell-cultured product] must be
- 10 labeled in prominent type equal to or greater in size than the
- 11 surrounding type and in close proximity to the name of the protein
- 12 [product] using one of the following:
- 13 (1) "cell-cultured";
- 14 (2) "lab-grown"; or
- 15 (3) a similar qualifying term or disclaimer intended
- 16 to clearly communicate to a consumer the contents of the protein
- 17 [product].
- 18 (c) The provisions of this subchapter apply to $\left[\frac{a}{a}\right]$
- 19 cell-cultured protein [product], as applicable.
- 20 SECTION 5. Subchapter D, Chapter 433, Health and Safety
- 21 Code, is amended by adding Section 433.057 to read as follows:
- 22 <u>Sec. 433.057. PROHIBITION ON CELL-CULTURED PROTEIN;</u>
- 23 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) In this section, "cell-cultured protein"
- 24 has the meaning assigned by Section 431.002.
- 25 (b) A person may not offer for sale or sell cell-cultured
- 26 protein for human consumption.
- 27 (c) To the extent another state law conflicts with this

- 1 section, this section controls.
- 2 (d) This section expires September 1, 2027.
- 3 SECTION 6. Section 431.0805(2), Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 repealed.
- 5 SECTION 7. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 6 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 7 Services Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
- 8 the changes in law made by this Act.
- 9 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
