4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 352, Estates Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 352.054 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 352.054. REIMBURSEMENT FOR CERTAIN COSTS FOR ASSIGNED
8	JUDGE. A statutory probate court judge assigned to hear a contested
9	matter on the motion under Section 32.003 of a party to the
10	proceeding shall, to the extent possible, order the estate to
11	reimburse a county for any amounts the county paid as compensation
12	and expenses in accordance with Section 25.0022(o-1), Government
13	<pre>Code.</pre>
14	SECTION 2. Section 25.0022, Government Code, is amended by
15	adding Subsection (o-1) and amending Subsection (p) to read as
16	follows:
17	(o-1) If a party to a probate proceeding files a motion for
18	the assignment of a statutory probate court judge to hear a
19	contested matter in the proceeding under Section 32.003, Estates
20	Code, and the motion is granted, the assigned statutory probate
21	<pre>court judge shall:</pre>
22	(1) to the extent possible, order that the county be

reimbursed for any amounts the county paid as compensation and

expenses under Subsections (o) and (p) from the estate under

- 1 Section 352.054, Estates Code, and from the parties to the
- 2 proceeding; and
- 3 (2) prescribe the amount and manner by which the
- 4 compensation and expenses described by Subdivision (1) are to be
- 5 equitably apportioned among the estate and parties, as applicable.
- 6 (p) In addition to all compensation and expenses authorized
- 7 by this section and other law, a judge who is assigned to a court
- 8 outside the county of the judge's residence is entitled to receive
- 9 \$25 for each day or fraction of a day served. Subject to Subsection
- 10 (o-1), the [The] county in which the judge served shall pay the
- 11 additional compensation from the county's general fund on
- 12 certification by the presiding judge.
- SECTION 3. Section 25.0022, Government Code, as amended by
- 14 this Act, applies only to a motion for the assignment of a statutory
- 15 probate court judge under Section 32.003, Estates Code, that is
- 16 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A motion filed
- 17 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 18 effect on the date the motion was filed, and the former law is
- 19 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
