A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the criminal offense of passing certain vehicles on a

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.157(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) This section applies only to the following vehicles:
- 8 (1) a stationary authorized emergency vehicle using
- 9 visual signals that meet the requirements of Sections 547.305 and
- 10 547.702;
- 11 (2) a stationary tow truck using equipment authorized
- 12 by Section 547.305(d);
- 13 (3) a Texas Department of Transportation vehicle or a
- 14 highway maintenance or construction vehicle operated pursuant to a
- 15 contract awarded under Subchapter A, Chapter 223, not separated
- 16 from the roadway by a traffic control channelizing device and using
- 17 visual signals that comply with the standards and specifications
- 18 adopted under Section 547.105;
- 19 (4) a service vehicle used by or for a utility, as
- 20 defined by Section 203.091, and using visual signals that comply
- 21 with the standards and specifications adopted under Section
- 22 547.105;
- 23 (5) a stationary vehicle used exclusively to transport
- 24 municipal solid waste, as defined by Section 361.003, Health and

- 1 Safety Code, or recyclable material, as defined by Section 361.421,
- 2 Health and Safety Code, while being operated in connection with the
- 3 removal or transportation of municipal solid waste or recyclable
- 4 material from a location adjacent to the highway; [and]
- 5 (6) a vehicle operated by or pursuant to a contract
- 6 with a toll project entity, as defined by Section 372.001, using
- 7 visual signals that comply with the standards and specifications
- 8 adopted under Section 547.105;
- 9 <u>(7) a vehicle operated by an animal control officer,</u>
- 10 as defined by Section 829.001, Health and Safety Code, for the
- 11 purpose of removing an animal or animal carcass from a roadway, or
- 12 <u>an individual authorized to dispose of a carcass of an animal under</u>
- 13 Section 361.117, Health and Safety Code, for the purpose of
- 14 removing an animal carcass from a roadway, and using visual signals
- 15 that comply with the standards and specifications adopted under
- 16 Section 547.105; and
- 17 (8) a vehicle operated by an employee of a local
- 18 authority for the purpose of issuing a parking citation and using
- 19 visual signals that comply with the standards and specifications
- 20 adopted under Section 547.105.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
