## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to parental approval for a student's participation in
- 3 human sexuality instruction in public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.004, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (i-2) to read as follows:
- 7 (i-2) Before a student may be provided with human sexuality
- 8 instruction, a school district must obtain the written consent of
- 9 the student's parent. A request for written consent under this
- 10 subsection:
- 11 (1) may not be included with any other notification or
- 12 request for written consent provided to the parent, other than the
- 13 notice provided under Subsection (i); and
- 14 (2) must be provided to the parent not later than the
- 15 14th day before the date on which the human sexuality instruction
- 16 begins.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
