9	In this section, "sweetened drink" means a nonalcoholic beverage
10	made with water that contains five grams or more of added sugar or
11	any amount of artificial sweeteners. The term does not include a
12	beverage that contains:
13	(1) milk or milk products;
14	(2) soy, rice, or similar milk substitutes; or
15	(3) more than 50 percent of vegetable or fruit juice by
16	volume.
17	(b) A recipient of supplemental nutrition assistance
18	<pre>program benefits may not use those benefits to purchase:</pre>
19	(1) a sweetened drink; or
20	(2) candy ordinarily packaged and sold for consumption
21	without further preparation.
22	SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
23	a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
24	federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

- 2 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
