1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the definition of facility for purposes of workplace
1-22 violence prevention requirements.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 331.001(3), Health and Safety Code, is
1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (3) "Facility" means:

1-27 (A) a home and community support services agency
1-28 licensed or licensed and certified under Chapter 142 [~~to provide~~
1-29 ~~home health services as defined by Section 142.001~~] that employs at
1-30 least two registered nurses;

1-31 (B) a hospital licensed under Chapter 241 and a
1-32 hospital maintained or operated by an agency of this state that is
1-33 exempt from licensing under that chapter;

1-34 (C) a nursing facility licensed under Chapter 242
1-35 that employs at least two registered nurses;

1-36 (D) an ambulatory surgical center licensed under
1-37 Chapter 243;

1-38 (E) a freestanding emergency medical care
1-39 facility as defined by Section 254.001; ~~and~~

1-40 (F) a mental hospital licensed under Chapter 577;

1-41 (G) an intermediate care facility for
1-42 individuals with an intellectual disability licensed under Chapter
1-43 252; and

1-44 (H) a state supported living center as defined by
1-45 Section 531.002.

1-46 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2026, a home and
1-47 community support services agency, intermediate care facility for
1-48 individuals with an intellectual disability, or state supported
1-49 living center that becomes subject to Chapter 331, Health and
1-50 Safety Code, under Section 331.001, Health and Safety Code, as
1-51 amended by this Act, shall comply with the requirements of that
1-52 chapter.

1-53 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
