S.B. No. 485

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the duties of care of certain landlords regarding 3 disasters. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 92, Property Code, is amended by adding 5 Subchapter J to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER J. LANDLORD'S DUTIES OF CARE REGARDING DISASTERS 7 Sec. 92.401. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: 8 (1) "Authorized resident" means a tenant or an 9 individual who is authorized by a lease to occupy a dwelling but who 10 is not obligated under the lease to pay rent. 11 (2) "Child," "disabled individual," and "elderly 12 individual" have the meanings assigned by Section 22.04, Penal 13 14 Code. (3) "Disaster" has the meaning assigned by Section 15 16 418.004, Government Code. (4) "Landlord" and "multiunit complex" have the 17 meanings assigned by Section 92.151. 18 Sec. 92.402. APPLICAB<u>ILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter</u> 19 applies only to the landlord of a multiunit complex in which any 20 authorized resident is an elderly individual, disabled individual, 21 22 or child. 23 Sec. 92.403. DUTIES OF CARE. (a) A landlord to whom this subchapter applies has the following duties of care: 24

1	(1) a duty to take all reasonable and necessary
2	precautions to protect residents of the multiunit complex from
3	foreseeable harm during a disaster;
4	(2) a duty to understand and prepare for conditions
5	that are more likely to affect an elderly or disabled individual or
6	child during a disaster, such as the need for mobility assistance
7	during evacuation or the need to access medication or medical
8	support;
9	(3) a duty to ensure that the staff of the complex are
10	trained and available to assist with resident needs during a
11	<u>disaster;</u>
12	(4) a duty to inform residents about dangers that may
13	arise in a disaster and provide instruction on how to respond to
14	those dangers; and
15	(5) a duty not to abandon the complex during a disaster
16	unless a mandatory evacuation of the area has been ordered under
17	Section 418.185, Government Code.
18	(b) The duty described by Subsection (a)(4) includes a duty
19	to implement a reliable system to alert residents of imminent
20	dangers and to provide clear and accessible information about
21	disaster plans and evacuation procedures.
22	Sec. 92.404. CAUSE OF ACTION. An authorized resident may
23	bring an action to recover damages resulting from a landlord's
24	breach of a duty of care imposed by Section 92.403.
25	Sec. 92.405. EFFECT ON OTHER DUTIES. Nothing in this
26	subchapter affects a duty of a landlord that exists under other law.
27	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
