- 9 SECTION 2. Article 58.151, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 Art. 58.151. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "victim"
- 12 means a person who is the subject of:
- 13 (1) an offense that allegedly constitutes:
- 14 (A) stalking under Section 42.072, Penal Code;
- 15 (B) invasive visual recording under Section
- 16 21.15, Penal Code; or
- 17 (C) indecent assault under Section 22.012, Penal
- 18 Code; or

- 19 (2) an offense that is part of the same criminal
- 20 episode, as defined by Section 3.01, Penal Code, as an offense
- 21 <u>described by Subdivision (1)</u> [under Section 42.072, Penal Code].
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
