4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 442, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 442.0205 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 442.0205. TEXAS HISTORY GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The
8	commission shall create and administer a grant program to support
9	the purpose of promoting educational engagement with the history of
10	this state. Subject to Subsection (b), the grants must be awarded
11	annually to nonprofit entities that:
12	(1) host a statewide Texas history competition for
13	school-aged students; and
14	(2) publish works on Texas history written by students
15	or faculty members.
16	(b) The commission shall establish procedures to administer
17	the grant program, including procedures for applying for a grant
18	under this section. The commission shall enter into a contract that
19	includes performance requirements with each grant recipient. The
20	commission shall monitor and enforce the terms of the contract.
21	(c) In addition to funds appropriated by the legislature,
22	the commission may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and donations
23	from any public or private source for the purpose of awarding grants
24	under this section.

1 SECTION 2. The Texas Historical Commission shall establish 2 the procedures for applying for a grant under Section 442.0205, 3 Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than October 1, 4 2025.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
